20.	C X serpentine of two loops width of arena. First loop true canter, second loop counter canter.	10
21.	Between X and E flying change of lead. E turn right.	10
22.	M F extended canter.	10
23.	F collected canter.	10
24.	V to I half-pass right collected canter. C turn right.	10
25.	R X V change rein. Flying change at X .	10
26.	V collected canter left. A turn left. X Halt. Salute.	10

Impulsion	Desire to move forward, elasticity of the steps, suppleness of the back and engagement of the hind quarters	10
Submission	Acceptance of the bridle, attention and confidence, harmony, lightness of the forehead, ease of movements.	10
Rider	Position and seat; correctness and effect of the aids.	10
