USEA Area Grants Adult Amateur Education Activities

The Endowment Trust has allocated a total of \$10,000 annually from the Le Samurai Fund for adult amateur educational programs within the USEA Areas. These generous grants are intended to be used by the USEA Area's adult rider programs for educational purposes in addition to the Area's allotments.

Each Grant will be given during the USEA's fiscal year, ending November 30, and cannot rollover into the next fiscal budget year. The Activities' organizer will complete the application and include the informational document advertising the activity's description and purpose. Within the USEA Areas, the Chairmen will select one per year for approval by the Endowment Trust and USEA. Grants will be allocated by October 1. Upon approval, the funds will be forwarded to the Area Treasurer and deposited into the Area Adult Rider Educational Accounts. The maximum grant request is \$1,000 per annum. The final summary report for the Grant sponsored education program must be forwarded to the Endowment Trust & USEA.

The Le Samurai Fund has been established by Rebecca Broussard and Amy Tryon in memory of the great four-star horse Le Samurai.
